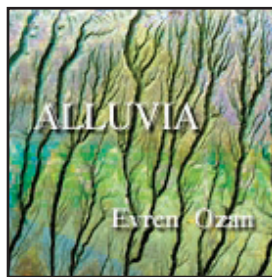

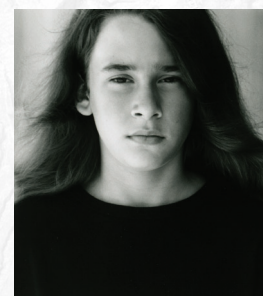
# Evren Ozan

In 1999, six year old Evren Ozan bought himself a Native American flute while visiting the Grand Canyon. Since then, he has released three albums, performed throughout the United States and Europe, been named a Davidson Fellow in Music, and won numerous awards, including 2007's Native American Music Award for Best Instrumental Album. Evren has appeared in national media such as National Geographic's WORLD, Inside Edition, Global Rhythms, and PRI's "The World" and his music -- roughly described as contemporary Native American flute with world fusion instrumentation -- is heard on international radio programs and many independent films. In addition to performances, Evren frequently visits schools and museums for musical demonstrations of Native American instruments.
